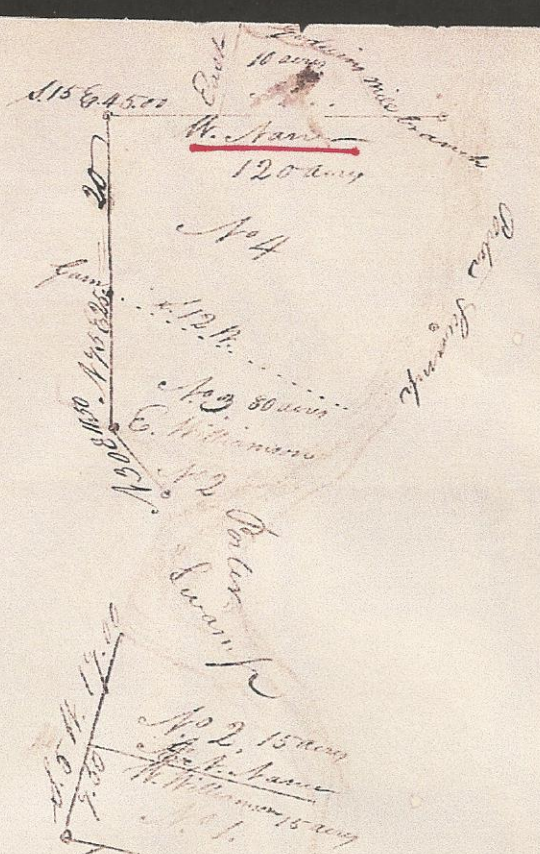

Pursuant to an order of court to us the undersigned clerk hereby directed, met at the house of Martha Name on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of March 1831 — and allotted to William Williamson Lot Number one adjoining the Widow Martha Name lower with an addition of 15 acres in Cow-branch Swamp Valued at One hundred Dollars — allotted to A. K. Name Lot Number two adjoining the above with the addition of three acres below the mouth of Poplar branch and thirty acres in Poplar Swamp Valued at one hundred Dollars allotted to Elias Williams seventy seven acres above the mouth of Poplar being the lower part of a 200 acres Survey owned by Stephens Gilmore to P. H. Name & D. Valued at one hundred & seventy four <sup>Dollars</sup> to pay No 1. 2 & 4. eight (Dollars each)

allotted to Hyman Name one hundred & twenty acres the up-  
per part of a 200 Acres Survey adjoining the Sheriff's land  
by Godwin's mill branch on the Dead Pond & named to  
Martin Noble Valued at One hundred Dollars
